

Associate Degree Nursing Selection Process Effective Fall 2022

Applicants are ranked for acceptance selection via a point award system. Maximum points awarded are **56 points** as indicated in the designated criteria below:

Support Course Cumulative GPA (minimum grade of "C" required)

Max 12 points

For each support course, you can earn 3 points for an A, 2 points for a B and credit for a C.

PSYC 2301 Gen. Psychology **OR** PSYC 2314 Lifespan Growth & Development – 3 credit hours BIOL 2402 Anatomy & Physiology II – 4 credit hours + BIOL 2420 Microbiology – 4 credit hours + Humanities or Fine Arts Elective – 3 credit hours

NOTE: BIOL 2402 must be completed before or with the first semester. BIOL 2420 must be completed before or with the 3rd semester of the Nursing Program.

HESI A² Test – Points are awarded for each of the following sections:Reading Comprehension, Grammar, Vocabulary, Math, Anatomy/Physiology
Must have a 80 or higher in each of the areas.

80 - 84 = 1 point 85 - 89 = 2 points 90 - 95 = 3 points 96 - 100 = 4 points
