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GROWTH METHODIST MIDLOTHIAN EXPANDS CARDIAC CARE

Methodist Midlothian completed a \$5 million expansion project in August to add a cardiac catheterization lab that features new equipment, interventional lab resources, and the most advanced technology to help patients with heart disease.

"A cardiac cath lab is a specialized area in a hospital where specialists diagnose



and treat coronary artery disease and heart attacks using tiny, flexible tubes called catheters to access the heart and its blood vessels," says **Roberto Wayhs, MD**, cardiologist on the medical staff at Methodist Midlothian.

The catheterization procedure helps physicians and nurses assess key measures of heart function, including blood pressure and blood flow, and it allows them to take scans of arteries to pinpoint life-threatening blockages. Because the most effective treatment is performed within 90 minutes of the onset of cardiac symptoms, having fast and convenient

access to a cath lab can be lifesaving, Dr. Wayhs adds.

"The cath lab will greatly enhance our ability to diagnose and treat a wide range of cardiac conditions, from the simplest to the most complex," says **Jary Ganske**, president of Methodist Midlothian. "This expansion helps meet the ever-growing need of care in Ellis County and provides additional resources for our hospital team and cardiologists on the medical staff."
